6. Be sure to eat before we go, bring a small snack for break and your own dinner, or money to buy dinner in Clinton. There will be approximately a 2-hour break for dinner and warm-up, as well as small breaks in rehearsal.
7. Daytime rehearsal dress: casual. Concert uniform; black shoes/socks, pants/skirt, and White shirt.
